



Physical Education Uniform

Pupils are expected to abide by school rules at all times, which includes wearing the correct uniform. In the case of PE uniform, that is as follows:

Girls PE Uniform

Indoor Uniform

White polo shirt
White ankle socks
White Indoor trainer/plimsolls
Navy KDHS Skorts

Outdoor Uniform

White polo shirt
Navy tracksuit with school badge (optional)
Navy sweatshirt with school badge (optional)
White Outdoor trainers / boots (optional)

Boys PE Uniform

Indoor Uniform

White polo shirt
White ankle socks or Navy football socks
Indoor trainer/plimsolls
Navy shorts

Outdoor Uniform

Navy cotton rugby shirt with reversible stripe
Navy tracksuit with school badge (optional)
Navy football socks
Outdoor trainers/football boots

Footwear

For safety reasons students involved in activities on grass surfaces it is recommended that pupils have the appropriate studded footwear. Indoor footwear must be different from the training shoes worn outside or must be thoroughly cleaned. They must also have non-marking soles and be laced properly and tied on the top of the tongues. Where possible athletics spikes will be provided for inter-school competitions.

General

Hair must be tied back from the face so that it doesn't impair vision and all jewellery must be removed.

Valuables

The responsibility of pupil's valuables is that of the pupil. We discourage students from bringing valuable or expensive items. Changing rooms are locked or valuables are collected while the lesson is in progress. These are stored in the PE Office.

Expected Behaviour of Pupils

It is expected that all pupils adhere to the school rules as stated in the Whole School Staff Handbook. Particular points of reference regarding Physical Education are;

- ✓ All pupils to arrive at lessons on time
- ✓ The appropriate uniform is worn for the activity
- ✓ All jewellery is removed and hair tied back
- ✓ To work co-operatively with others in group activities, this includes aiding the skill development of themselves and others

- ✓ To be respectful to staff, other pupils and the facilities/equipment
