

SCHOOL UNIFORM

- Skirts must be loose fitting, navy blue with tick pleats front and back, and **MUST BE WORN AT KNEE LENGTH OR BELOW AT ALL TIMES.** Skirts only available from School stockists.
- Navy stripe open neck blouse with reverses, long sleeved. Jumper optional.
- Shoes - plain black leather school shoes that are raised less than 6 cms – no logos or stripes or materials other than leather. No trainer types.
- Knee length socks (up to Batmitzvah) after which tights – must be plain, navy blue or black.
- Navy blue blazer with school badge. Badges can be purchased at Yavneh, must be worn at all times.
- Plain navy blue v-neck jumper. Sweatshirts and cardigans are not permitted.
- A siddur.

P.E.

- Indoor trainers (with soles which do not mark)
- Outdoor trainers
- White socks – can be ankle length
- Plain white polo shirt
- Navy blue skirt available to order from Yavneh
- Navy briefs
- Plain navy blue Speedo swimming costume available from the School stockists
- School swimming cap (available from Yavneh)
- Tracksuit/sweatshirt (optional), only available from School stockists
- Goggles (optional)
- Towel & toiletries. Spray deodorants are not allowed (shower facilities available)

It is school policy that students attending lessons without appropriate kit will be issued with clean equipment by the P.E. department.

ALL ITEMS OF CLOTHING MUST BE MARKED WITH THE PUPIL'S NAME.

Pupils are required to have a school bag which will adequately protect text and exercise books.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

All uniform must be:

- Clean and in good repair e.g. no jumpers with frayed sleeves
- Worn correctly – blouses must be tucked into waistbands, sleeves rolled down

PLEASE NOTE

Any breach of uniform or equipment rules will result in disciplinary measures being taken

Pupils must ensure that they are always smart in appearance:

- Never wear any make-up – if make-up is detected, pupils will be required to remove all traces. If the offence is repeated it will be treated as defiance and punished accordingly.
- Never wear nail varnish or nail extensions
- Never wear jewellery – this includes chains with Magen David symbols, Chai symbols etc. (There is no religious reason for wearing any jewellery during school times.)
- Girls are permitted one plain stud in each ear lobe.
- Plain wristwatches are permitted
- Shoulder length hair must be tied back with a navy or black bobble
- Braided hairstyles are not permitted

Failure to comply with any of these requirements will result in a verbal warning. Pupils will be expected to return to school next day having complied with these regulations.
