

DRUGS POLICY

The King David High School policy on this issue is clear, unequivocal and exacting.

The possession of drugs on the campus is absolutely prohibited.

The school's ethos is the Jewish ethos which demands that our children know, when the need arises, how to say NO.

The assistance of outside organisations will be involved in educating the pupils on the use and misuse of drugs.

Procedure

1. Pupils must tell a member of staff if:
 - They are offered drugs
 - A friend or another pupil is known to have drugs in their possession
 - They witness anyone using drugs
 - They witness any pupil passing drugs to another pupil.

2. The incident will be recorded, parents will be informed and investigations by Senior Management and the Police (where appropriate) will commence immediately.

3. The school's attitude to such cases – if proven- will be uncompromising. Pupils in possession of drugs on the campus will be permanently excluded.

SMOKING POLICY

The smoking of cigarettes and vaping on campus is strictly prohibited for all pupils / students and, if found, the items will be confiscated. In addition, pupils and students risk a fixed term exclusion.

Smoking or vaping on campus is a serious offence
