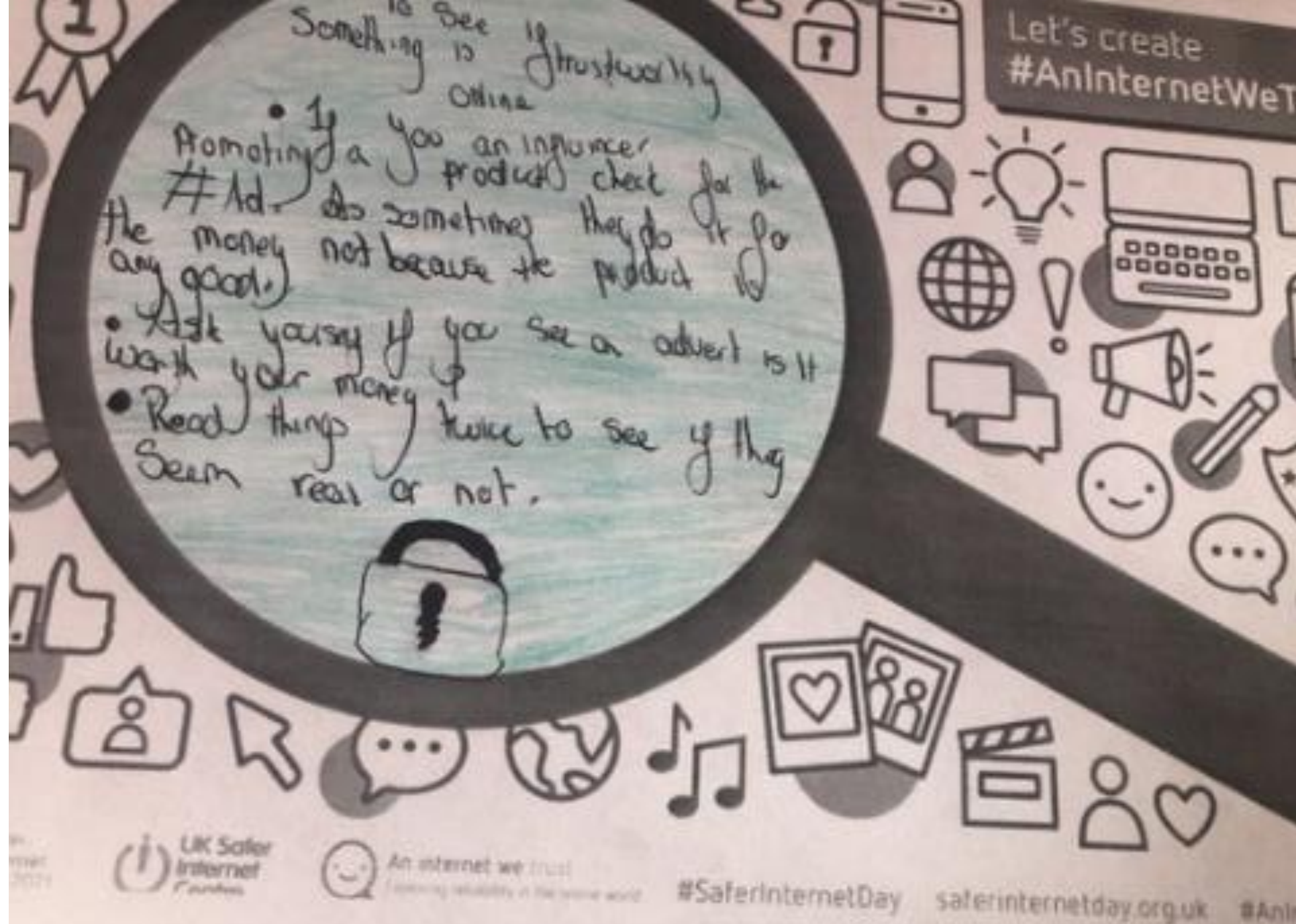
Don't Trust anything

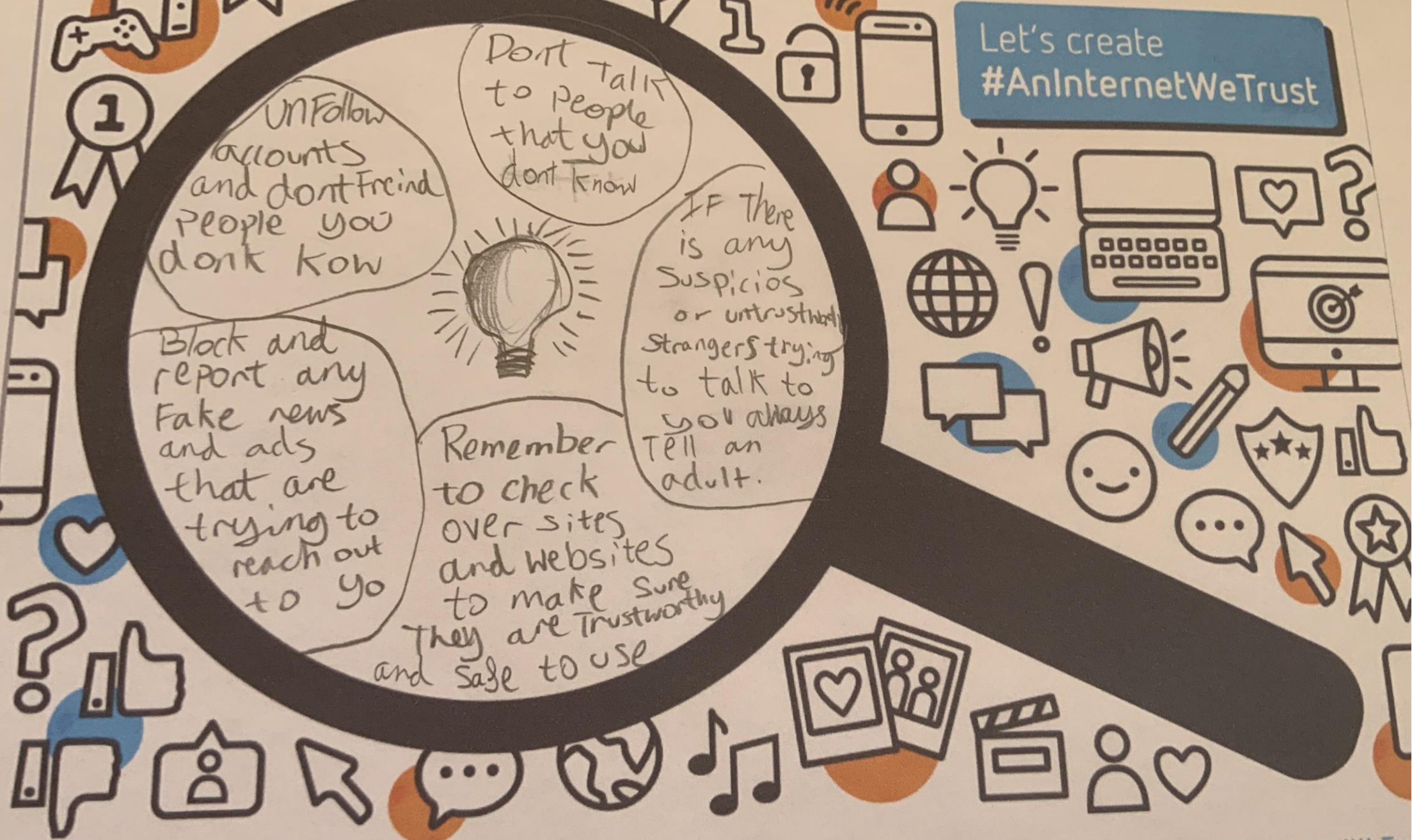
